- You will receive appropriate acknowledgement and recognition.
- You can be assured that information about your donation will be handled with respect and with confidentiality to the extent provided by law.
- You can expect that all relationships with individuals representing an interest to the donor will be treated by us in a professional manner.
- You will be informed whether those seeking donations are our employees, volunteers, or third party agents hired to seek donations.
- You have the opportunity to have your name deleted from our mailing lists.
- You can feel free to ask questions when making a donation and to receive prompt, truthful and forthright answers.
- You have the right to complain and the right to receive a satisfactory response.
- We will not sell, trade or share a donor's personal information with anyone else, nor send donor mailings on behalf of other organisations.
- We will only share personal information once the donor has given us specific permission to do so.
